Youth for Christ Ballysillan

In recent years we have helped with the renovation and upkeep of the 'Blue Houses' - two houses knocked into one. They now form a purpose built youth and resource centre in a socially disadvantaged area and act as a base for YFC outreach activities in the area. Young people and YFC leadership have visited Legacurry on a number of occasions sharing encouraging stories of lives being challenged and changed.

Drogheda Presbyterian Church

Through the auspices of the Board of Mission in Ireland our church has developed close ties with Drogheda Presbyterian Church in Co Louth. Under the ministry of Rev John Woodside this church has grown dramatically in recent years to the extent that a new church will have to be built. They have also sought to reach out into the city centre, opening a drop in centre in 2008. Legacurry has been able to help with both projects and looks forward to further developing our ties in the future.

Jackie Burke

Jackie is a local man living in Lisburn. After many years of drug and alcohol abuse Jackie's life was dramatically changed when he decided to follow Jesus. He now has dedicated his life to sharing his story with young people and warning them about the dangers of drugs. Jackie spends his time visiting a wide range of schools and youth clubs right across Ireland.

OMF

For the last number of years the church has been supporting the work of the Overseas Missionary Fellowship, formerly known as the China Inland Mission. This mission organisation now operates in the whole of South East Asia working with a diverse range of ethnic and social groups. As well as evangelism

it is involved in Healthcare, Education, Agriculture and in the training and mentoring of national Christians. Local Directors Wilson and Irene McMahon speak at our church on a regular basis.

AEAD

For the last 6 years our church has developed very close ties with AEAD – a Christian education and developmental organisation based in Burkina Faso in West Africa. Pastor Phillippe Oudreago who founded and directs the organisation, has visited Legacurry several times and teams from our church have been to Burkina Faso where they have helped with various educational and agricultural projects. These links have been further strengthened through our involvement with an internationally based Christian charity, Friends in Action - a group which seeks to help missionaries and national Christians in practical ways. For the last 4 years we have, on an annual basis, sent out teams to Burkina Faso to help with well digging projects. In 2008 we distributed one tonne of Burkina Faso mangoes imported directly from AEAD.

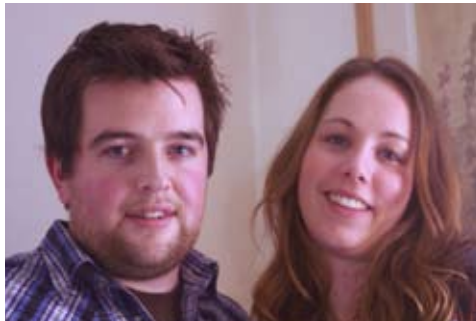
Morales Family Peru

Pastoral Care

Prayer Ministry

We have a team of people trained in prayer ministry. You can receive prayer for any need in your life or for a friend or relative. After a brief introduction and explanation, two members of the team will pray with you in private. This ministry is available in the Upper Room of the halls after the Sunday morning church service. All matters discussed are strictly confidential.

Prayer Chain

We operate a prayer chain with some 50+ people on it contacted by text message, email and telephone. This is available for all members of the congregation. Those being prayed for can be named or remain anonymous.

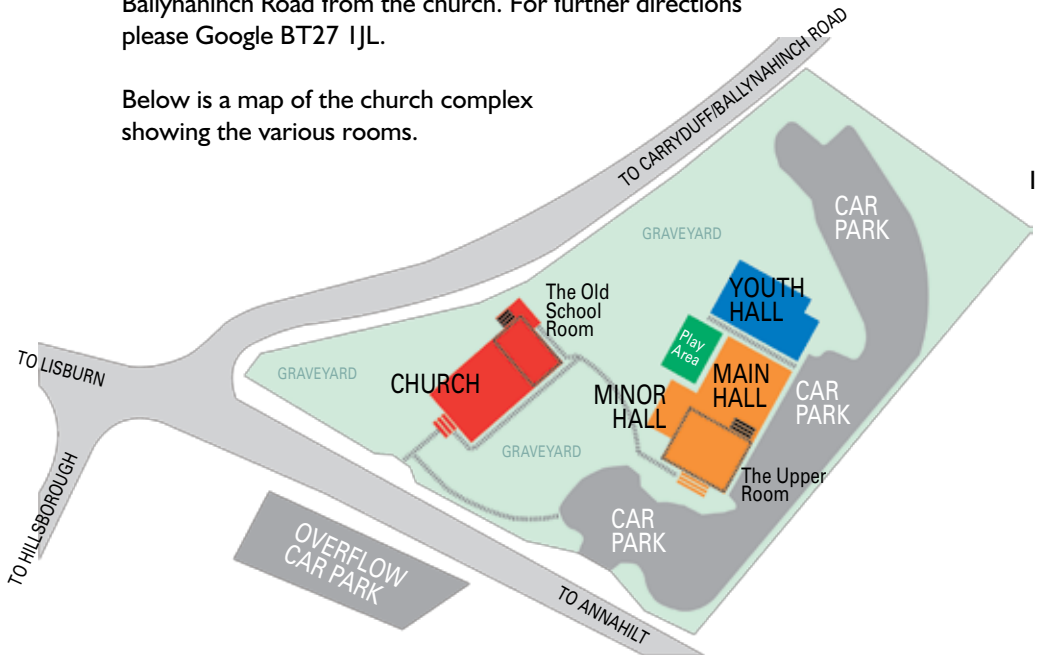


Map and Directions
