We have 116 students in our main program (Bachelor of Theology) and several more enrolled in other programs. I'm lecturing two subjects this term (Christian Education and Church Management). My studies are going ok. I got good marks in my subjects. That is very encouraging and also it is a blessing. It is very challenging to study in a foreign language but I'm feel confident that God has a purpose for me. I will take two subjects about Statistics next June. That will be a real challenge. As I told you last year I applied for some scholarships in order to cover my travel expenses. Unfortunately I couldn't get any grant because my degree was not mainly on Theological area. That made me feel very discouraged at first but I'm sure that now is when I have to trust on God and He will work. Help me praying for Jessica and kids while I'm away. Our family project is still there: to visit you in January 2012. I know it is far yet but we want to start praying and let God works.
